- > Giuseppe Arcimboldo was an Italian painter best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of objects such as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish and books.
- > Andy Warhol was an American artist, director, and producer who was a leading figure in the visual art movement known as 'Pop Art.'
- > 'Pop Art' is an art movement that emerged in the United Kingdom and the United States during the mid- to late-1950s.
- > Pop art is a style of art based on simple, bold images of everyday items, such as soup cans, painted in bright colours.



Key Vocabulary	Definition (Include a mix of art and music key terminology)
<b>Line</b>	A distinct straight or curved lines placed against a background
<b>Pattern</b>	An arrangement of <b>lines</b> or shapes, especially a design in which the same shape is repeated
<b>Colour</b>	Color is the element of <b>art</b> that is produced when light, striking an object, is reflected to the eye.
<b>Shape</b>	Shape is a flat, enclosed area of an artwork created through lines, textures and colours.
<b>Composer</b>	A musician who is an author of music in any form, including vocal music.
<b>Crescendo</b>	The loudest point reached in a gradually increasing sound.
<b>Diminuendo</b>	A gradual decrease in volume of a musical passage.
