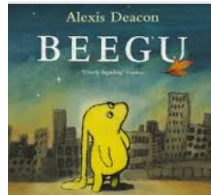


Year 2 Autumn Term Newsletter

Planners

Children must bring their planner into school everyday so that they are able to utilise it during lessons. Each planner contains lots of information which children can access including knowledge organisers, which allow children to know more and remember more. The planners also contain pages for your home reading record and for weekly homework expectations.

Homework

Homework will be set on a weekly basis on our Class Dojo page. At the front of their planner, there are pages with how to access the online platforms. There are spaces for

your child to write what they have read about. Please encourage your child to log on Times Table Rock Stars and Spelling Shed as often as possible.

Reading/Phonics

Children will shortly be issued with a home reading book. This book must be brought into school everyday. Children will be listened to and books will be changed accordingly. There is support in planners to help children with their phonics and other useful resources. Children continue to practise weekly speed sounds.

PE
