Curriculum

It's beginning to sound a lot like Christmas at Rivers Primary Academy this week as classes are learning their Christmas songs and Reception are practising their Nativity. It has also been lovely to see some of the fantastic artwork that has been taking place as part of 'Diversity in the Arts' and hearing some of the facts children have been learning about the countries from which the artwork has originated from. Children have also been learning about disability awareness month through discussing in Votes for Schools, 'Does social media make it easier to talk about disabilities?' (KS2) or, 'Do celebrities help us talk about disabilities?' (KS1)

Year Group Focus: Year 1

This week, Year 1 has been learning about materials and their properties in science. They sorted lots of different objects by the material they were made from and they also used words such as hard, soft, bendy and smooth to describe the materials. They then used what they had learned about the different properties of the materials to plan and complete an investigation: to find the material that would be the most suitable for a coat to keep Barnaby Bear dry. They predicted which would best and then tested it out by dripping water onto the different materials. They found the best material was the plastic because it was waterproof.




Artist of the Half Term: Leonardo da Vinci


