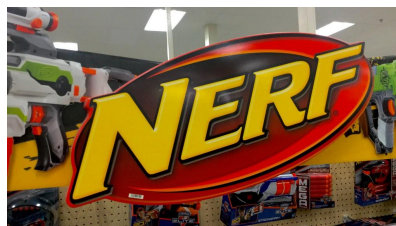
After our ASPIRE theme, we will have another DT theme and after February half term, we look forward to starting our second history theme.
