



## COVID-19 Catch Up Premium 2020/21 Website Information

Our 'Emerging Stronger' response to COVID-19 has been carefully and extensively planned. A key part of this response has been the creation of a detailed and focused 'Accelerated Learning' plan. The plan sets out our strategies to ensure that the COVID-19 interruption does not impact on students reaching their academic and personal potential. E.g. Y2 Phonics Screening: 82% December return to LA - one of highest in Walsall.</li> <li>Attendance: Despite Covid-19 interruptions, student attendance has been similar or better than levels seen nationally. With Covid-19 absence taken out of the data, Rivers has seen attendance rates above 95% in some terms.</li> </ul>
Programme of out of hours learning opportunities     Summer school for children transitioning into a new key stage and entering Y6 to immerse them back into schooling and recapping basic skills.     Summer school to support children's academic and personal potential.	
<ul> <li>Early Years</li> <li>Purchase and resourcing of Welcomm and Talk Boost</li> <li>Additional teaching assistant in the afternoon to boost children's speech and language.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Early Reading</li> <li>RWI reading teacher working across EYFS and KS1 to embed RWI Phonics</li> <li>Daily 121 phonics coaching delivered via RWI reading teacher and TA each afternoon across KS1</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Pastoral Team</li> <li>Nurture groups and 121 work with individual children to meet children's SEMH needs and enable them to remain in class and access learning.</li> <li>Increased SLT and pastoral team interventions such as a walking bus regarding attendance, particularly targeting PA families.</li> </ul>

- Targeted year groups and individuals to attend physical lunch and after school fit clubs led by PE specialist
- Half-termly whole-school competitive activity eg skipping in Autumn Term 1 and whole-school Black Country Rainbow Day focusing on exercise, nutrition and mental health.
